**ANDREW BERRINGTON** – Woodwind instrument maker will host clarinet **maintenance** sessions, explaining how to best care for your instrument, and some emergency repair tips

**NITZAN KARNI** – **Alexander Technique** practitioner will conduct workshops to help reduce stress and increase stamina in performance.
