COMPETITION RULES & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Entries close 5pm Friday 21st August 2009. Late solo entries will be accepted until 5pm Wednesday 26th August with a \$5 late fee. **NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THIS TIME.**
- Please note that solo **performance times will be emailed by Monday 31st August**, and **ensemble times by Monday 24th August**, and that **all contestants must submit a current email address.**
- Contestants will be within age limit requirements (age at 1/01/09)
- Solo contestants competing need to be a member of ACAS/QCASS.** This excludes soloists in the under 11 & 13 years sections.
- Ensemble groups must have at least one ACAS/QCASS member (conductor included).
- Winners may be required to provide birth certificates to judges and organisers if requested.
- All section winners are invited to play in a Prize Winners Concert (Sunday 25th October).
- The Committee reserves the right to recall any contestant for a second performance in the case of a possible tie.
- Time limits should be strictly adhered to. Any performer exceeding the time limit may be disqualified.
- Only one entry per solo section per performer allowed.
- The adjudicators' decision is final.
- No competitor, parent, guardian or teacher may communicate with adjudicators during the Competition.
- Contestants will receive two written adjudications available at the end of each section.
- Contestants are required to supply copies of music to the adjudicators at least 15 mins before their section. Photocopied material will not be returned.
- The Committee reserves the right to interpret the application of any rules.
- Ensembles may consist of three or more players - clarinet, saxophone or a combination of woodwind instruments including clarinet and/or saxophone. Wind quintets are acceptable. Jazz ensembles including drum kits or amplified instruments are acceptable but the entrant must inform the Coordinator well before the Competition.**
- An official accompanist is provided on the day of the competition, at a cost of \$10.00 per section. Please indicate on the Official Entry Form if you require the official accompanist. Should you wish to rehearse with accompanist prior, please contact the administrator.
- Prior rehearsals are at the Competitor's own expense and need to be arranged with the official accompanist.**
- CD backings are welcome but the entrant must inform the Coordinator well before the Competition.
- Entrants may provide their own accompanist at their own expense.
