## ARTISTS and PRESENTERS...

**ANDY FIRTH** - Andy Firth is not only one of the finest clarinet and saxophone players on the music scene today, but he is also a gifted composer and a dedicated educator. Wherever he performs, he leaves critics and fellow players gasping in awe of his ability to either dazzle with his blindingly fast, fluent technique or his soulful, beautiful tone. In short, a musician of extraordinary technique and finesse.

PATRICK NOLAN - From 2001 to 2006 Patrick held the position of Principal Flute with the Queensland Orchestra and before that, from 1987 to 2000, he was Principal Flute with the Queensland Philharmonic Orchestra. He commenced music studies with Vernon Hill and Thomas Pinschof at the Victorian College of Arts and continued his studies in Vienna with Wolfgang Schulz, principal flautist of the Vienna Philharmonic. Patrick has been widely praised for his artistic direction of the highly successful Tenth Australian Flute Convention held at the Queensland Conservatorium in 1999. He also coordinated the 1999 Australian National Academy of Music Flute Program. Patrick has taught flute at the University of Queensland, Queensland University of Technology and at the Queensland Conservatorium, Griffith University.

**ANDREW BERRINGTON-** Trained as a woodwind instrument maker in Germany and worked for Trevor J James in London and John Lehner flutes in Sydney before starting For Winds in 1991. Since selling the company For Winds to Musicorp in 2004, and working as manager of retail and repairs for the company, in 2007 Andrew then went back to his roots, doing what he loved - Instrument repairs. Since June 2010 Andrew has been enjoying the role as Sales Manager for the Buffet Crampon Group of companies including Buffet, Besson, Keilwerth, Courtois and Schreiber.
