## Reinventing the Clarinet

After years of development and by working with top clarinet artists, the new Yamaha CSG III clarinets have a variety of new features and innovations that are sure to increase the popularity of the Custom range.

Developed closely with Jérôme Voisin, solo clarinet with Orchestre Philharmonique de Radio France, the new CSG has a warm yet focused sound surrounded by a wealth of overtones, resulting in extraordinary beauty and expression.

The bore has a new treatment and the barrel. which has a thicker wall, is now 1.5mm shorter than the previous one, giving the player a deep tone colour with rich resonance as well as creating more resistance. A change to the tone hole design has maximised the balance between intonation and projection and a new, thicker plating has created a more flexible instrument capable of producing an intense, brilliant sound.

To complement these changes, Yamaha have also created a more ergonomically designed Eb lever offering a more comfortable and natural key feel and an optional E/F pitch correction lever.
