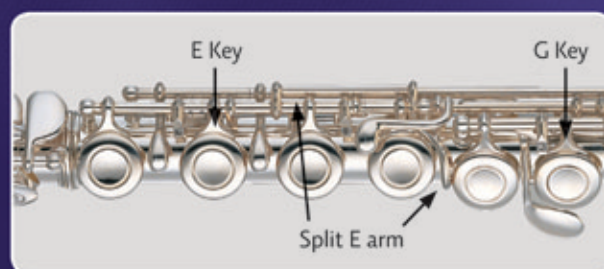

So, what is 'Split E mechanism'?

The Split E Mechanism is an optional feature on some flutes that makes the 3rd octave E more far more responsive. The way it works is by dividing the action of the upper and lower G keys. With the Split E Mechanism, the lower G key closes, making the E much easier to play in tune.
